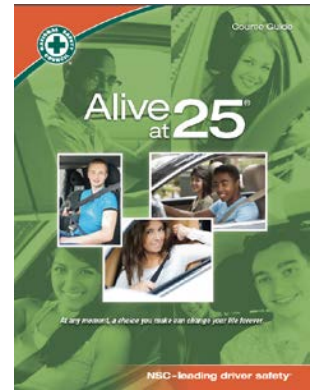




NSC Alive at 25, 4th edition

E-Learning Instructor Certification Course

Only certified NSC DDC Instructors can teach Alive at 25. The classroom Instructor Development Course for Alive at 25 will not be available with the 4th edition. New Alive at 25 instructors must successfully complete the NSC E-Learning Instructor Course for Alive at 25, which will be available January 2017.

The NSC E-Learning DDC Instructor Training program is a web-based curriculum providing prospective DDC instructors with foundational knowledge about NSC DDC courses, defensive driving techniques and guidelines, and instructional standards for each course.

NSC DDC E-Learning Instructor Training is delivered to candidate instructors online using a modular approach providing interactive elements to engage learners and promote learning, including audio narration, videos, animations, games, and knowledge checks. The Alive at 25 E-Learning courses is segmented into 4 units and will take about 12 hours to complete.

Candidate instructors are not considered certified until they have satisfactorily completed all of the E-learning modules associated with Alive at 25 and are then observed delivering the DDC course at least twice in a given year.

Following are the requirements for obtaining certification to teach Alive at 25:

- Attend an actual session of the DDC course. This gives the candidate a sense of the types of individuals that are trained, the flow of the course, and the types of issues that are raised.
- Satisfactorily complete Unit 1, Unit 2, Unit 3 and Unit 4 DDC E-learning courses in the Instructor Training program.
 - Unit 1 – DDC Foundation
 - Unit 2 – DDC Facilitation & Classroom Management
 - Unit 3 – Choice Theory / Reality Management
 - Unit 4 – Teaching Course for Alive at 25
- After completing the Instructor Training e-learning course, you must then facilitate a minimum of two probationary sessions of the DDC course for which they have completed the Unit 4 e-learning course.

Upon successful completion of these requirements, the instructor will be issued an instructor credential with an identification number. Instructor credentials are valid for 12 months and carry an expiration date. They must be renewed annually.
