CEVO 3 Fire Classroom – 6 hour

Vehicle Inspection and Characteristics

Self-appraisal and checklist review

Cushion of Safety

Blind spots, scanning, stopping and following distances and speed, and reaction time

Driving with Lights and Sirens

Defensive driving techniques in emergency situations, intersections, controlling emotions while under pressure

Applying Safe Driving Techniques

Analyzing potentially hazardous traffic situations and driving scenarios and reviewing collision prevention solutions

Special Considerations

Collision reporting procedures, backing, adverse weather conditions, fireground safety and returning to a fire and self-appraisal review

Final Test
