OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard 29CFR 1910.1030

The employer shall ...

- ✓ provide annual training for each employee with occupational exposure in accordance with the requirements
- ✓ ensure appropriate personal protective equipment is available
- ✓ make available the Hepatitis B vaccine and vaccination series to all employees who have occupational exposure
- ✓ Maintain an Exposure Control Plan

The person conducting the training shall ...

- ✓ be knowledgeable in the subject matter covered by the elements contained in the training program the ready availability of medical personnel
