Web-based courses and registration for courses not taught by APD

APD's Web-based training and non-APD classroom training registration is a cooperative effort with private industry. Various required training courses are available on several websites. First is a list of the websites that offer classroom training for CPR. Second is a list of web-based courses and locations APD currently recognizes as meeting handbook training requirements. Classroom trainings of the web-based courses below are also acceptable for AIDS/HIV/Infection Control and First Aid.

Only classroom training is acceptable for CPR and APD does not provide this training. However, the followings links will take you to the website for approved organizations so that you may find a classroom training to attend. The link is on the left and the course title of the acceptable course(s) is shown to the right.

American Red Cross	acceptable course = First Aid, CPR and AED
American Heart Association	acceptable courses = Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers, Heartsaver CPR, AED with written test, or Heartsaver First Aid, CPR and AED with written test
American Health and Safety Institute	acceptable course = CPR and AED
Emergency Care & Safety Institute	acceptable courses = CPR and AED; Health Care Provider CPR; Standard First Aid, and CPR and AED
National Safety Council	acceptable courses = First Aid, CPR and AED and CPR & AED
EMS Safety Services, Inc	acceptable courses = CPR and AED for Professional Rescuers

The following listing is for acceptable web-based required training courses offered by specified organizations. The title of the course requirement is listed on the left with the specific course title in **bold**. On the right (across from the course title) is a link to the organization that provides that training for your easy access. Some required courses have several course titles that will meet the requirement, while others only have one. Please pay close attention so that you take a course that does meet handbook requirements.
