Signs of **poisoning**

Headaches,

Reduce the **risk**

- Maintain and tune up devices that produce carbon monoxide
- Never use small gas-powered engines in enclosed spaces
- Keep work areas well ventilated
- Install carbon dioxide monitors and alarms
