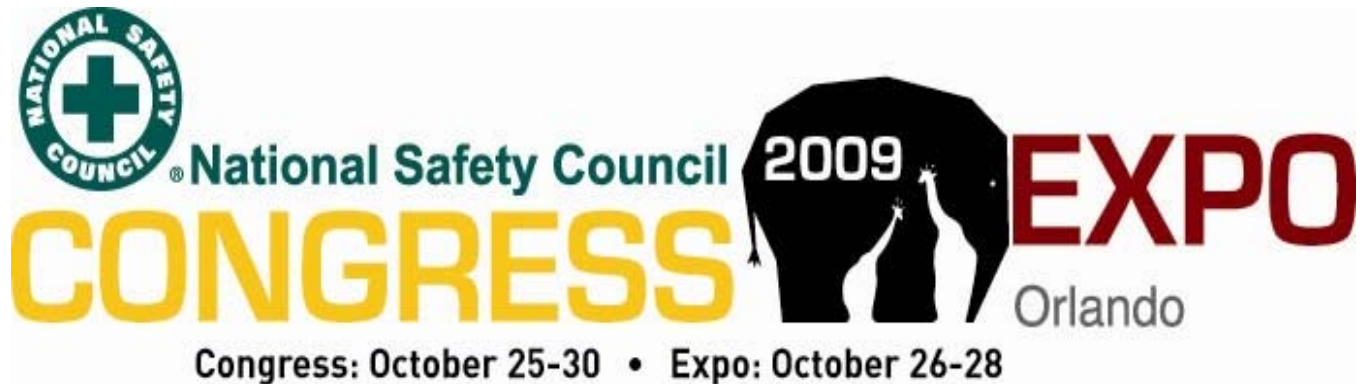

Credit for Attending

- The Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP) will award 0.5 COC for at least one full day, but less than two days of attendance at the NSC 2009 Congress & Expo. For two or more days of attendance, 1.0 COC will be awarded. No points are awarded for less than one full day of attendance.
- The American Board of Industrial Hygiene (ABIH) will award 0.5 Safety CM points for each half-day of attendance at the NSC 2009 Congress & Expo. For 2009, NSC has received ABIH approval for the awarding of Safety CM points for attendance at Congress & Expo, as well as the awarding of either IH or Safety CM points for each of the NSC 2009 Congress & Expo Professional Development Seminars (PDS). In general, 0.5 CM points are earned for every half-day of participation in an NSC 2009 Congress & Expo PDS.

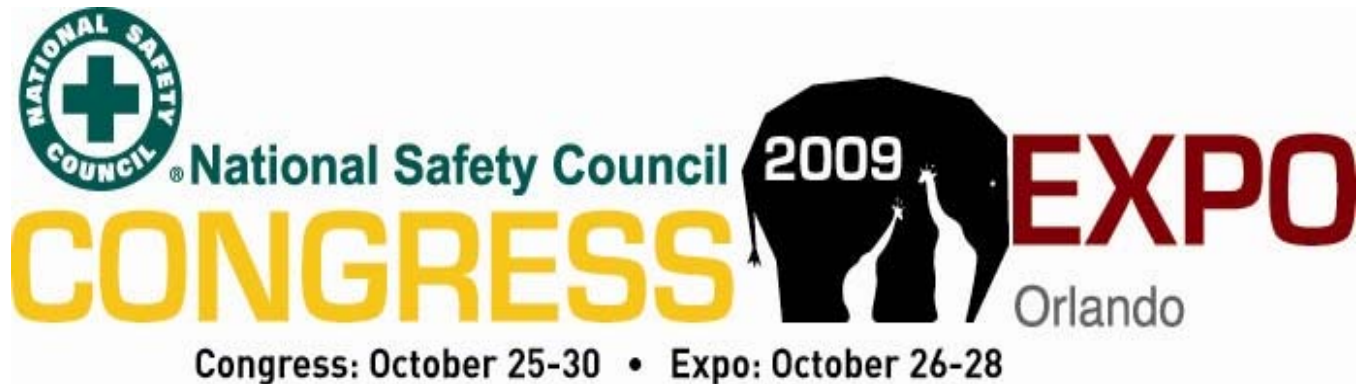
