## 2009-2010 SAFE DRIVER AWARD PROGRAM FACT SHEET

The following are some highlights of the current agreement  
valid through September 2009–September 2010

The following program components ARE covered under the current USPS Contract (and can be ordered at no charge to you):

- Safe Driver Lapel Pins and Wallet Cards  
(Wallet cards offered free upon request with 1-45 Year Safe Driver Lapel Pin orders)
- Million Mile Plaques and Pins (30 accumulated years)  
(Pins offered free with Million Mile Plaque orders, replaces Million Mile Brass Wallet Cards)

The following program components ARE NOT covered under the current USPS Contract (but can be purchased separately):

- Expert Driver Certificates
- Safe Driver Shoulder Patches
- Two Million Mile Plaques

### Product/Coverage Notes:

- Safe Driver Lapel Pins are covered by the contract and are available in years 1-45. Wallet Cards are offered free upon request with Safe Driver Lapel Pin orders. Safe Driver Wallet Cards are printed on laser printer-compatible stock enabling all USPS facilities to personalize the wallet cards, if desired.
- Million Mile Awards are covered by the USPS contract and recognize a driver who has achieved 30 accumulated years of driving without a preventable accident. A Million Mile Pin is free with each Million Mile Plaque order.
- Expert Driver Certificates are not covered under the USPS contract, but are available for purchase for \$8.00 each, plus shipping and handling. The Expert Driver Certificates are personalized with the driver's name and the number of years driven without an accident.
- Safe Driver Shoulder Patches are not covered under the USPS contract, but are available for purchase at a cost of \$2.55 each (1-999 qty.) and \$2.00 each (1000+ qty.), plus shipping and handling.
- Two Million Mile Plaques are not covered under the USPS contract, but are available for purchase at a cost of \$70.00 (1-9 qty.) and \$62.00 (10+ qty.), plus shipping and handling.
