



## **NSC Community Training: Surviving an Active Shooter Event**

The National Safety Council is a nonprofit whose mission is to eliminate preventable deaths in our lifetime. To advance our mission, we educate and advocate for safe behaviors and should people find themselves in an active shooter event, uncommon as it is, we know there are key behaviors that can help save lives. The Council seeks to empower people to be safe.

Consider partnering with NSC to train people in your community to be prepared.

**WHY:** Training can replace useless panic with effective action. NSC believes preparing for emergencies is a valuable skill that can easily be taught with the right tools.

**WHO:** Training can be led by anyone who can effectively speak in front of groups and follow detailed course materials. We recommend alerting your local law enforcement, who are experts on this topic, to support your training.

**WHAT:** Training materials include a publicity kit to promote your training to media and the public: a press release template, poster, flier, etc. Course materials include a planning guide, manual, slides and videos for instructors as well as participant guides and certificates for attendees. NSC will provide registration support.

**WHEN:** Training is scheduled by the instructor for an optimal time for the community to attend. The training course runs 2 hours.

**WHERE:** Training venue is determined by the instructor.
