

## **HUESTIS BIOGRAPHY:**

An Adjunct Professor at the University of Maryland School of Medicine, Professor Dr. Dr. (h.c.) Marilyn A. Huestis spent 23 years of conducting controlled drug administration studies for the National Institute on Drug Abuse and National Institutes of Health. During her career, Professor Huestis served on the National Commission on Forensic Sciences, was president of the Society of Forensic Toxicologists, Chair of the Toxicology Section of the American Academy of Forensic Sciences, and president of The International Association of Forensic Toxicologists, among many other positions, awards, and recognitions.

Professor Huestis has published 459 peer-reviewed manuscripts and book chapters, has received a Doctor Honoris Causa from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Helsinki in Finland, and has been recognized numerous times for her teaching, research, and expertise in toxicology and the forensic sciences, including being identified as an “Inspiring Mind” by *Clinical Chemistry*. She currently serves on the Steering Committee of The *Lambert Center* for the Study of Medicinal Cannabis and Hemp, the Smart Approaches to Marijuana (SAM) Science Advisory Board, is the Senior Scientific Advisor of NMS Labs, acts as Consultant to the US Department of Transportation, and is President of Huestis & Smith Toxicology, LLC. In addition, she serves on the Organization of Scientific Area Committee on Toxicology, World Anti-doping Agency’s Prohibited List Committee, Transportation Research Board Committee on Alcohol and Other Drugs, and the National Safety Council’s Alcohol, Drugs and Impairment Division Executive Board.
