## The National Safety Council Honors 55 Organizations with 2013 Industry Leader Award

Itasca, IL – The National Safety Council today announced 55 organizations have been awarded the Council’s 2013 Industry Leader Award for safety performance within their industries. Winners are selected based on North American Industry Classification System code, lowest total incidence rate and employee work hours.
