**DISCUSSION REGARDING PROPOSED RULE MAKING
ELECTRONIC ON BOARD RECORDERS.**

On January 31, 2011 the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) issued a regulatory proposal that would require interstate commercial truck and bus companies to install electronic on-board recorders (EOBRs) to monitor their drivers' hours-of-service (HOS) compliance. Under the proposal, interstate carriers that currently use Records of Duty (RODS) logbooks to document drivers' HOS would be required to use EOBRs. Short-haul interstate carriers that use timecards to document HOS would not be required to use EOBRs.

This forum is being conducted by the National Safety Council in an effort to give members of the Transportation Safety Division the opportunity to hear both sides of the issue and offer their comments to the National Safety Council who may be providing comments to the FMCSA at a later date.
