Driver error causes 70% of motor vehicle collisions. This course helps change driver attitude improving driving behavior. The program is specifically designed for court referrals, as a diversion program for drivers with excessive violations, or for drivers with poor driving habits.

Course description:

Problem drivers may lack driving skills, but most often it's their attitude that leads to dangerous driving behavior. Convincing problem drivers that the choices they make result in serious financial, legal and personal costs is the first step in getting them to change their "behind-the-wheel" behavior. This course focuses on dialogue, so participants can identify their needs/expectations, ask questions, share their opinions and join group discussions in a non-threatening, non-judgmental environment.
