Position/Policy Statement

Radar Detection Devices

The National Safety Council encourages the Federal Government to revise the Federal Motor Carrier Safety regulations to prohibit the possession and use by commercial drivers of devices designed to detect the presence of police radar instruments or to reduce the effectiveness of such instruments. The National Safety Council also encourages all state legislatures to prohibit the sale, possession or use of such devices by any person.

This position statement reflects the opinions of the National Safety Council but not necessarily those of each member organization.
