What does my registration cover? 2026 Spring Labor Division Meeting registration includes

Meeting Location: The Baltimore Convention Center, 1 W Pratt St, Baltimore, MD

The Spring Labor Division meeting will be held in meeting rooms 327-329, on level 3 of the Baltimore Convention Center. Registration tables will be set in front of the meeting rooms.

- From the Hilton Baltimore: Enter the convention center via the skybridge connecting the 2nd Floor of the Hilton to the Pratt Street Lobby on Level 3 at the Baltimore Convention Center. Follow signs to meeting rooms 329-329
- From the Hyatt Regency Baltimore: Enter the convention center from the Charles Street entrance and proceed up the escalators to Level 3, the follow signs to meeting rooms 327-329
- From other hotels: Enter the Convention Center from the Pratt Street entrance, located at the corner of Pratt and Howard Streets. Take the escalator up one flight to meeting rooms 327-329

Can I bring a guest to the Labor Division Reception? Yes you can. Register your guest(s) using the information in your confirmation email. All guests must have a badge, be registered and 16 or older.

Cost is \$20 per guest. Labor Division meeting attendees do not need to register for the reception as it is included in your meeting registration.
