Position/Policy Statement

Workers' Memorial Day

At its meeting November 4, 1992, National Safety Council Board of Directors approved the following proposal originally submitted by the Labor Division to the Governmental Relations Committee:

“That the National Safety Council recognize and promote April 28th as Workers' Memorial Day to honor all those workers who have lost their lives because of occupational hazards.”
