

# Billy D. Young Memorial Scholarship

The NSC Construction & Utilities Division honors Billy D. Young – the first NSC Public Utilities Division chair – with this scholarship in his name. Given to students who are pursuing a career in safety in the utilities industry, the Billy D. Young scholarship provides the winner a \$2,000 tuition award.

All Billy D. Young Memorial Scholarship recipients are also provided the opportunity to attend the NSC Safety Congress & Expo at no cost, with access to technical sessions, keynote addresses, an Expo of over 1,000 exhibitors and networking events. The NSC Safety Congress & Expo is the world's premier annual safety event, bringing together 14,000 occupational safety and health professionals from various industries.



### Eligibility

- Students seeking post-secondary education leading to a career in safety in the utilities industry
  - Students attending community colleges, technical programs, apprenticeships or bachelor's degree programs within the United States (both in-person and online), enrolled full-or part-time, and graduating no earlier than May 2023
  - · Part-time candidates may receive a prorated award
- Applicants not employed in a full-time position at the time of application will receive priority
- For those who are attending programs without EHS majors, at least 25 percent of course work each semester must be safety-related

#### **Application and selection**

- To be considered, applications must be fully completed and submitted online no later than April 1, 2022
- One letter of recommendation must be submitted with the application
- · At least one and up to three letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application
- · Completion of an application does not guarantee a scholarship award
- Finalists will be notified in May 2022
  - Finalists will be asked for additional information, verification of claims and to supply transcripts
  - Finalists must pass a media review, and will need to reveal any criminal history prior to final submission
  - Criminal history may be a factor in the decision whether or not to award the scholarship
- NSC staff and volunteers will have access to the information provided on all applications







#### **Award Information**

- Recipients will receive a check in the amount of \$2,000 payable to the university/college
  - The \$2,000 award may be prorated if the recipient is not a full-time student
  - Recipient will need to sign an acceptance agreement stipulating use of funds for tuition, books and supplies

## **NSC Safety Congress & Expo Attendance**

- This scholarship will fully fund attendance to the NSC Safety Congress & Expo including registration, transportation, lodging, and per diem
- All travel arrangements are completed by the National Safety Council system; other reservations or travel arrangements will not be reimbursed
- The total value of this scholarship varies annually by location of the NSC Safety
  Congress & Expo and by recipient due to variance in travel costs from around the country

### **Essays:**

- Why did you choose to study safety? (limit 500 words, approximately one page, single-spaced)
- What are the most important issues in safety today? (limit 250 words, approximately one-half of one page, single-spaced)
- Why do you deserve this scholarship? (limit 250 words, approximately one-half of one page, single-spaced)

Letter of recommendation (one is required; three may be submitted)
