NSC Congress & Expo Scholarship recipients will be provided a travel grant to attend the event at no cost, with access to technical sessions, keynote addresses, an Expo of more than 1,000 exhibitors and networking events. This is an invaluable opportunity for scholarship recipients to meet and learn from thousands of safety and health professionals. The NSC Congress & Expo is the world's premier annual safety event, bringing together 14,000 occupational safety and health professionals from various industries. Scholarship Rules and Guidelines

Eligibility

- Students seeking post-secondary education leading to a career in safety, or a closely related field
 - Students attending community colleges, technical programs, apprenticeships or degree seeking programs within the United States (both in-person and online), enrolled full- or part-time and graduating no earlier than May 2024 are eligible
 - Part-time candidates may receive a prorated award
 - · Graduate students are eligible
- Applicants may not be employed in a full-time EHS position at the time of application

Application and Selection

- To be considered, applications must be fully completed and <u>submitted online</u> no later than May 15, 2023
- At least one and up to three letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application by May 15, 2023
- · Completion of an application does not guarantee a scholarship award
- Finalists will be notified by June 2023
 - · Finalists will be asked for additional information, verification of claims and to supply transcripts
 - Finalists must pass a media review, and will need to reveal any criminal history prior to final submission
 - Criminal history may be a factor in the decision whether or not to award the scholarship
- NSC staff and volunteers will have access to the information provided on all applications







NSC Congress & Expo Attendance

- This scholarship will fully fund attendance to the NSC Congress & Expo including registration, transportation, lodging and per diem
- All travel arrangements are completed by the National Safety Council system; other reservations or travel arrangements will not be reimbursed
- The total value of this scholarship varies annually by location of the NSC Congress & Expo and by recipient due to variance in travel costs from around the country; no international travel will be funded



Application Details

The application will be available online at <u>Submittable</u>. Below is a list of questions that will be included in the application:

- Why are you interested in learning more about a career in safety? (limit 500 words, approximately one page, single-spaced)
- Why are you interested in attending the NSC Congress & Expo? (limit 250 words, approximately one-half of one page, single-spaced)
- Why do you deserve this scholarship?
 (limit 250 words, approximately one-half of one page, single-spaced)

Letter of recommendation (One is required; three may be submitted)
